These trainings equip pharmacies to build and operate a compliant, profitable program while strengthening their role as trusted healthcare providers in their communities. The standing order, issued directly to the pharmacy and covering all enrolled immunizers, authorizes the administration of 17 vaccines, including RSV, influenza, pneumococcal, acute herpes zoster, hepatitis A, hepatitis B, human papillomavirus, measles, mpox, mumps, rubella, varicella, COVID-19, and more. Last year, 77 pharmacies participated, and enrollment is expected to increase again this year.
